No food or drinks in the Gym or outside!

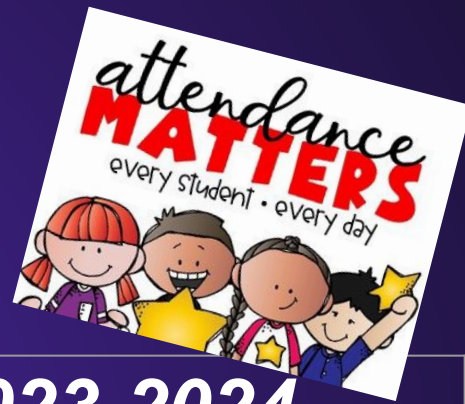
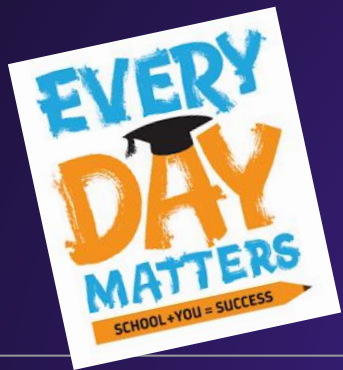
Please remember to return ice packs to the office. We are running very low. Thank you!
