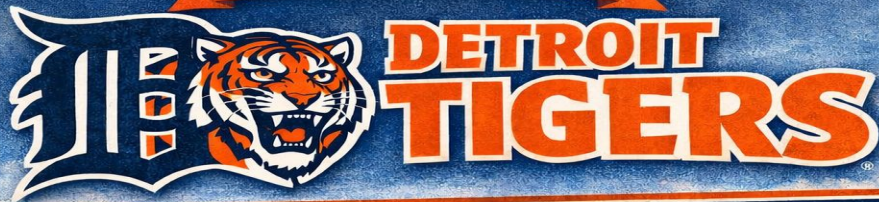

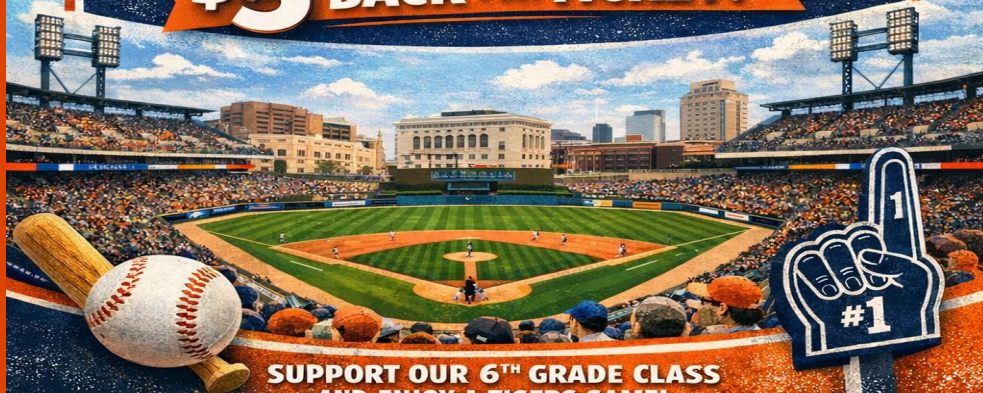

# REMINDERS

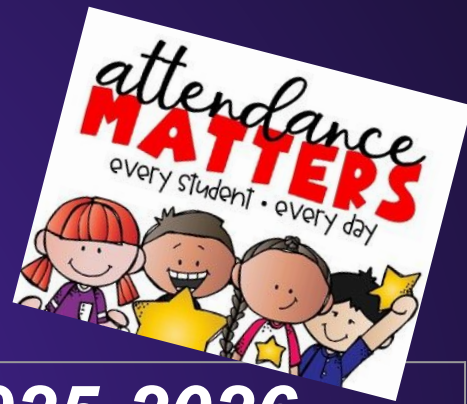
