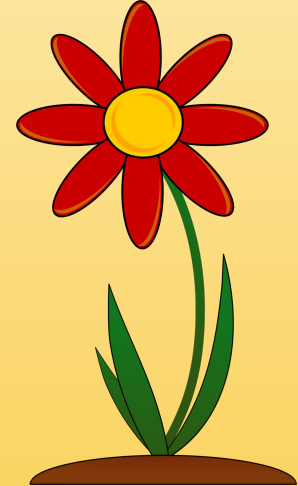

No outside chromebooks, computers, devices are allowed. You must use your school issued device.

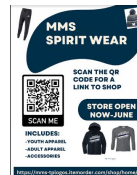


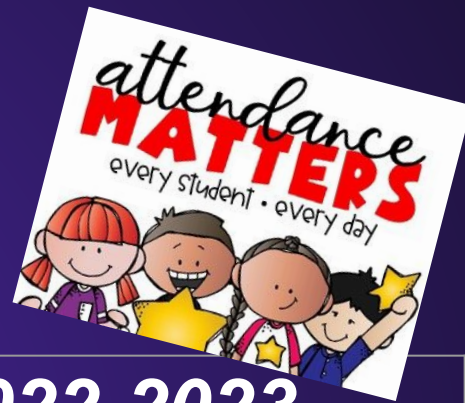

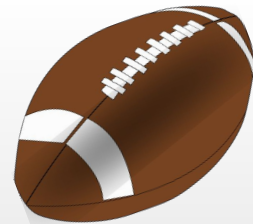
