-IF any students were unable to attend Viking Days to get their picture taken or they wish to have their picture retaken, please mark your calendar for Friday, October 4th. Picture retakes will take place Oct. 23rd from 8:00-11:30 am in the Auxiliary Gym.

Student Services Office

Attendance

All students should attend school regularly. Attendance is considered an essential component in determining whether a student has earned credit towards graduation, and credit might not be earned because of excessive absenteeism. Regular attendance will allow students to keep up academically, since classroom instruction and the presentation of materials by teachers in all classes takes place in an orderly, sequential manner. In addition to missing class time, students will also miss valuable time to interact with both teachers and other students if they do not attend school regularly. The chance to hear and participate in class instruction, discussion, and other related learning

experiences cannot be replaced. Please view the student handbook for details on our

attendance policy.

Excusing Absences

In the event of an absence, a parent/guardian must contact the school attendance line and provide explanation: 810-364-7313, The administration reserves the right to determine what is an excused or unexcused absence or tardy for school purposes. If prior contact is not possible, the parents should provide a written excuse as soon as possible. When no excuse is not provided, the absence will be unexcused and the student will be considered truant.

Student Parking

Permits must be purchased annually by student drivers and are \$30 this year. Applications are available in Student Service. Individual spots are unassigned and available on a first come, first served basis. Applications require a parent/guardian signature before submission. Permits are required to be on display inside the vehicle at all times on campus. Only standard vehicles (no golf carts or similar) are allowed.



Student Services is located between the Main Office and Athletic Office. This office oversees Attendance and Student Behavior. The Counseling Office and Student Wellness Center (School Nurse and Clinical Therapist) are also located here.

Leaving / Returning to School

No Student shall enter or leave the building during the school day without obtaining permission and checking in or out with Student Services. Parents/Guardians, please make sure to CALL AHEAD if you need your student released early. If a student is at school and needs to leave due to illness, it is necessary that the student calls or texts home from the Student Services Office. Students will be excused to leave school only after a parent or administrator's permission has been granted. Students must check out with Student Services before leaving the building. This includes leaving campus between classes. To ensure attendance is correct, checking in and out with Student Services is critical. Not following the proper procedure will result in the absence being recorded as unexcused.
