Dear Marysville Staff,

Thanks to the continued support of our community, the Marysville Public Schools Bond Proposal approved in August is now moving from vision to action. We anticipate that all bond projects will be completed over the next two years, with the majority of construction occurring during the summers of 2026 and 2027 to minimize disruption to learning. In order to keep our school community informed I will be providing regular updates as to the progress of the work.

We are currently in the initial planning and design phase, developing timelines and sequencing the work that will take place. Each improvement supports our district vision of providing safe, innovative, and inspiring spaces. The first phase of work focuses on several high-impact areas that will immediately enhance safety, learning environments, and facility reliability. Proposed first phase projects include:

- High School mechanical upgrades
- Elementary renovations, including significant updates to each media center
- Security enhancements including door and lock replacements around the district
- Fire alarm system replacements at the elementary and middle schools
- Parking lot improvements across multiple sites
- Tennis courts and practice field improvements

The second phase of work will focus on improvements at the middle school, high school, additional athletic spaces, and elementary playgrounds.

We are committed to including our staff in the planning process. For example, our elementary principals recently visited other recently renovated media centers to help shape designs that support collaborative, flexible learning spaces for students and adults. They will work closely with staff and students to create spaces that reflect the unique needs of each school.

We will continue to share updates as plans progress and designs take shape. Thank you for your continued dedication to our students and your partnership as we take this next step in strengthening Marysville Public Schools for generations to come.
