Dear Marysville Community,

I am excited to share an update on the progress of our bond projects and what you can expect as we head into a very busy and productive summer across our district. Behind the scenes, a tremendous amount of planning and preparation has been underway to ensure our summer work is efficient, organized, and impactful. We have already begun to see progress, including the completion of new fencing around the JV baseball outfield, the beginning of the stadium parking expansion, and work on the high school climate control system. Here are some things you can expect to see over the summer:

- All elementary buildings will be closed to staff and students this summer as significant renovations take place. These improvements include:
  - Complete remodels of each elementary media center/library
  - Installation of new windows and flooring in select classrooms
  - Select student bathroom upgrades
- The High School will also be closed for several weeks this summer as work on the geothermal system requires glycol to be drained, temporarily eliminating the air conditioning and at times the air circulation system.
- Parking lots across the district will be replaced
- Tennis court and practice field resurfacing to improve safety
- Security enhancements including door and lock replacements around the district
- Beginning the process of updating fire alarm systems across the district

Due to the construction and building availability, the majority of our summer programs will be held at Marysville Middle School. This includes elementary summer school, driver's education, and our summer meal program. We appreciate the middle school team for the use of their building so we can continue to provide these important programs. Additionally, we have worked with our Athletic Director and Marysville Recreation Department to minimize the impact to programs that utilize the high school pool and gyms.

Our maintenance team will be working tirelessly alongside our construction management partners throughout the summer to ensure that all projects are completed and our buildings are ready to welcome students and staff back in September.
