1. Letter of Introduction

Please read the letter and make note of the forms to be returned.

2. Physical Examination

Have your doctor fill out the form titled HEALTH APPRAISAL. Bring the form properly filled out and signed by physician at the time of round up or before school begins in the fall. (Physicals are recommended, but not required).

3. Vision and Hearing Screening

Vision and Hearing screening is required for all Kindergarten students. Washington Elementary will be hosting two Kindergarten screening sessions through the Health Department, April 17th and May 2nd. Please call 810-364-7101 to schedule an appointment. If you are unable to have your child tested on those dates, testing may be done at your doctor's office or you may call the Health Department at 987-5300 to schedule an appointment.

4. Official Birth Certificate

School office personnel must see and make a copy of your child's official Birth Certificate, which indicates the birth certificate number.

5. Official Residency Verification

The school office will need two (2) official documents proving residency. Acceptable documentation includes driver's license, utility bill and purchase or lease agreement. All documents must show current name and address.

6. Forms to be Returned

The following forms (from your packet) need to be completed and signed by a parent/guardian prior to returning to the school:

- A. District Enrollment form
- B. Health Appraisal Form
- C. Student Residency Questionnaire
- D. School Bus Transportation Form all students, regardless of regular transportation method to and from school.
- E. Home Language Survey
- F. Temporary Placement Form (Students with an IEP)
- G. Concussion
- H. Pre School Experience and Care Form
- I. Records Release (if child transferring from another school or has an IEP)
