Dear Parent(s),

Welcome to Marysville Public Schools! We are looking forward to having you and your child(ren) participate in our full-day kindergarten program next year. As part of our enrollment process, we will need to have the following documentation from you:

- 1. <u>PROOF OF RESIDENCE</u> in Marysville Public Schools (e.g., driver's license, tax receipt, utility bill with name and address, etc.) or, a completed "Schools of Choice" application.
- 2. Certified <u>BIRTH CERTIFICATE</u>, which will be copied and returned to you.
- 3. <u>PHYSICIAN'S STATEMENT</u>, verifying immunization against diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, measles, rubella, polio, and Hepatitis B. Two does of measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) are also required for all children entering school. If the fourth dose of DTP and the third dose of OPV have not been administered on or after your child(ren)'s fourth birthday, a booster host is required. Additionally, all new entrants into the district <u>MUST</u> be immunized against chicken pox. If parents chose not to immunize their child, parents/guardians <u>MUST</u> make an appointment at a local health department for one-on-one immunization education. After the education, if the parent/guardian still wishes to sign a waiver, the waiver is signed and certified at the local health department. The parent/guardian must then turn the waiver in to the school. Children <u>MUST</u> be up-to-date on their immunizations, be in a provisional state, or have a valid waiver on file <u>BEFORE</u> starting school.
- <u>DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH STATEMENT</u>, indicating that your child(ren) passed a preschool vision and hearing test, or evidence of having their eyes and hearing tested after the age of three.

Our school principals and staff are all eager to work with you so that your child(ren)'s enrollment goes as smoothly as possible. Consequently, if you have any questions, comments, or concerns, please contact them at your earliest convenience.
